The purchaser has been told verbally as well as in writing previous to the sale of this dog, _____ that this dog is being sold as a PET ONLY and that it must be spayed/neutered at 6 months of age (or earlier) at the **Purchaser's expense.**

*It is the responsibility of the ORIGINAL PURCHASER to ensure that ____(SELLER)_____ has received verification that the spay/neuter surgery has been performed **BEFORE the dog's age of 7 months old**, before the date of _____ Verification of this dog's spay/neuter must be received by ____SELLER_____, **no later than _____**. Failure to comply with this agreement by the date stated above will be considered a breach of this contract, and the PURCHASER **will then be liable for the dog's full breeding value, additional to the original sale price.**

*Purchaser is to send a copy of their Vet's invoice bill along with the performing Vet's name (printed), Vet's signature, phone number, and address, as well as the date the surgery was performed. Any proof of surgery must include description of the dog (breed and age).** (A proper form has been provided to the purchaser at time of sale to send back to ____SELLER_____ after the surgery has been performed. Form includes description of the dog, dogs date of birth, blank spaces for date the surgery was performed, owners name, vet office's name, phone number, address, and a space for the Vet who performed the surgery to print and sign their name for verification.) **This information must be sent to SELLER NO LATER THAN _____.**

*By the purchaser's signature below, He/she agrees to have this dog spayed/neutered BEFORE THE DATE OF _____ and the purchaser understands that this spay/neuter agreement is an agreement that this dog **will not** produce a litter of puppies either as purposely bred or by accidental breeding. Accidental breeding is considered neglect. **Should any type of breeding occur, the purchaser will be responsible for the full breeding value of the dog, additional to the original sale price.**

*This contract is still your (the original purchaser's) responsibility to enforce in the dog's new home, should you sell/trade/give away this dog.

If the dog is to die for any reason BEFORE its spay/neuter has been performed, a certificate of death from a veterinarian (including the owners name, date of death, description of dog (breed, color, age), vets name, number, address, AND SIGNATURE) **obtained at the purchaser's expense (will not be reimbursed) must be given to ____SELLER_____ before the date of _____ or the purchaser **WILL be responsible for the full breeding value of the dog additional to the original sale price.**

* Should we not receive conformation of the dog's spaying or neutering by the above listed date, as the original purchaser, **you will then be liable for the dogs full breeding value additional to the original sale price. Purchaser will also be responsible for any legal fees incurred by seller in the event that this contract is breached.
